Azure Intro

Resource Management

The available options when creating Virtual Machines in Azure are covered. Scaling VMs, VM Backup and VM Disaster Recovery are part of the course program as well.

Azure Networking

Then there is attention to networking in Azure with the implementation of Azure Virtual Networks, Azure DNS, Azure VPN Gateway and the Azure Firewall. Network Security Groups and Azure Load Balancing will also be discussed.

Access Management

The program of the course Azure Administration also includes how Access to Azure is regulated. Attention is also paid to Azure Active Directory, the assignment of roles and the implementation of Multi-Factor Authentication.

Storage Services

Azure Storage Services are also covered, such as Blob Storage, File Storage, Queue Storage and Disk Storage. Accessing SQL and No SQL Databases in the Azure Cloud will also be treated.

Azure Compute Services

And Azure Compute Services are explained, such as the App Service, the Kubernetes Service and the Batch Service. Serverless Computing and Azure Functions are also discussed.

Exam Preparation

Finally participants learn how to prepare for the Microsoft Certified Azure Administrator Associate exam (AZ-104). The questions from various test exams are treated and tips are given to help you pass the exam.
